CSME's NEW CLUB LOCOMOTIVE



The club obtained Lizzy a few years ago. A simple Bagnall 0-4-0 design with Hackworth valve gear published in the Model Engineer. Jon Shaw also planned to build one, started with the frames, obtained boiler materials as well cylinder, wheel and chimney castings. He started with laser cut frames, and at one stage we drilled the frame holes with the DRO in my workshop.

Jon decided to sell and parted with the part built parts, selling them to Derrick Louw. Progress was slow and I offered to take the parts over and complete it as a club loco. Derrick assisted to weld the boiler, and also did the beautiful paint job.

Overall dimensions were maintained, but the boiler was slightly enlarged due to available materials, valve components were upgraded, and needle roller bearings were fitted all over. The tank was a simple construction welded from stainless steel plate. A suggestion was made to fit a crosshead pump, which turned out very well.


I worked on it over a period of 3 years, between other club projects and loco repairs. It carries one of Jon's locomotive nameplates, No 2, as well as mine No 9, and a Centurion Society number 11.

When the loco needed a name, Jon suggested that we name it after his wife's second name Teresa, all that was outstanding was to make the nameplate.

We commissioned the loco during the month, with the official unveiling. Jon had to dig deep to remember his steam driving skills, as he had no choice to take it for a few rides around the track.



The raised track area promises to become a scenic feature of CSME.



CSME 32 - 45mm G Scale Track



The 32-45mm CSME upgrade underway. Slow progress but we hope to get some speed with the first bridge fibre cement castings to commence this week.

We will fence up two crucial areas, the Gautrain Bridges and Fountains Valley Bridge areas. This is to ensure public interaction with the models is BY EYES ONLY, and keep the models owners sane and at ease.

We installed new floating barriers under bridge one and two in order to isolate the hyacinth east of the bridges.
